### **School sport survey**

We have received the results of the Welsh schools sports survey, our individual school results were very positive when compared to the average results of the 1,095 schools who took part.

#### **Motivation:**

**100%** of pupils stated that they would like to more sport of some kind, compared with **97%** in Wales.

#### **Confidence:**

**86%** of pupils state that they are either very or quite confident in trying new activities, compared with **84%** of pupils in Wales.

#### **Opportunity & Resources:**

Roch C P provides **12 extracurricular activities** throughout the year compared to the Welsh average which is **8**.

#### **Experience:**

**74%** of pupils stated that they **enjoy PE** 'a lot' and **74%** stated that they **enjoyed extracurricular activities** 'a lot', compared with Welsh pupils in general who reported **enjoying PE** 'a lot' **73%** and **extracurricular activities** 'a lot' **60%**.
